

Jewelry Care Checklist

ORGANIZATION

- Separate jewelry by type (rings, earrings, bracelets, necklaces) to prevent tangles and scratches.
- Store softer metals like gold away from harder metals like platinum to prevent scratches.
- Keep gemstones in a cool, dark spot.
- Store pearls and amber separately in breathable bags to avoid drying out.

STORAGE

- Store jewelry in a cool, dry, and dark place. A jewelry box with velvet lining is ideal.
- Use anti-tarnish strips or felt pouches for additional protection, especially for silver jewelry.
- Store pearls in a soft cloth bag and keep them away from heat and harsh chemicals.
- Consider using silica packets in your storage container to absorb excess moisture.
- Avoid storing jewelry in plastic bags (except for costume jewelry) as it can trap moisture and accelerate tarnishing.

CLEANING

- Clean your jewelry before storing it to remove oils, lotions, and residues that can cause tarnishing.
- Use the appropriate cleaning solution for the type of metal or gemstone (consult a jeweler for specific recommendations if needed).
 - Mild soap and water for gold, silver (plated and non-plated), and costume jewelry.
 - Special cleaning solutions for gemstones (consult a jeweler for specifics).
- Always pat jewelry dry with a soft cloth after cleaning to avoid moisture damage.
